The international scope of the event extends to Europe and other parts of the world. Attendees can look forward to insights from experts such as Marcos Gomez Hidalgo, Deputy Director at

INCIBE-CERT, and Michel Van Den Berghe, President of the Cyber Campus in Paris, a project initiated by President Macron.

Industry giants, including Microsoft, Trend Micro, IBM, and Sentinel One, are slated to attend. The forum will also spotlight cybersecurity experts from esteemed entities such as Google Cloud, Meta, NBA, and the National Bank of Canada. With such a convergence of thought leaders, the anticipated 5,000 attendees can expect profound discussions and unparalleled networking opportunities.

In April 2023, the FBI, in coordination with Europol and numerous international partners, disrupted the online criminal marketplace known as Genesis Market. The "Cookie Monster Operation" will be the subject of a panel discussion featuring its very own protagonists: Amanda J. Knutson (FBI), Marcello Zanini (Europol), Brian Abellera (FBI), Chris Lynam (NC3), and Andrée Dupuis (Quebec Safety).

This is just a glimpse of what the program offers. Attendees will experience 6 thematic scenes, a hacking lab, a pitch lab, and an exclusive gala cocktail at the Saint James Theater for VIP badge holders.
